### **Festival of Intercultural Dialogue**


This is a new project developed by the International Network from May to October 2018. Following the theme of the Route - the Intercultural Dialogue and the ancient Mediterranean civilizations - the proposal of promoting a Mediterranean event that combines literature, communication, food, fashion and so on has been approved. The first edition foresees the organization of events in 4 Mediterranean countries, from Lebanon to Spain (Melilla), passing through Italy (Sicily) and Malta.

#### **Ancient Theatres. Our contemporaries.**

A development project, funded by MiBACT - Italian Ministry of Cultural Heritage and Tourism for the valorisation of the less known ancient theatres and archaeological sites in Italy and the Mediterranean through shows and storytelling. QAcademy, thanks to the collaboration with the Phoenicians' Route will identify ancient places/theaters active in the territories that are part of the Route. The development of the project at an international level is in line with the aims of the European Year of Cultural Heritage aspiring to promote, as well as other enhancement programs, the creation of partnership networks for possible membership in the programs. ## Project "33 Islands"

A cultural and intercultural sail boat cruise on the Phoenicians' Route 2018. An unusual journey through all the Italian inhabited minor islands, performed by an Italian oceanographer on a small and original sailboat, in order to promote intercultural thanks also dialogue, to the collaboration of a documentary filmmaker and a photographer. From April to August countries and people will be reached in the name of the Phoenicians' Route, also through an engaging online communication, to promote the values of the Route, of the Council of Europe and of the European Year of Cultural Heritage. The project is expected to be developed over the next few years, so that it can affect all the smaller Mediterranean islands.





#### **Ancient Mediterranean Days**

The annual event of the Phoenicians' Route "Ancient Mediterranean Days" is back, an event that includes numerous initiatives and activities of various kinds (conferences, exhibitions, meetings, guided tours, twinnings, intercultural travel, and more) on the value of the Ancient Mediterranean Civilizations for today's Intercultural Dialogue in many countries belonging to the International Network. The 2018 Edition will be dedicated in particular to the European Year of Cultural Heritage and the activities that will take place in the months of March, April and May are included in the calendar of this great European Cultural Event. #### **International Workshop**

As opening event of the "Ancient Mediterranean Days", an International Workshop called "Heritage and dialogue between past and present" was organized in Castelvetrano, Sicily, in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Castelvetrano - Valle del Belice. The event was attended by some members of the Scientific and Steering Committee of the Phoenicians' Route.





The Campania Museum Pole with the Municipality of S. Maria Capua Vetere will host the exhibition "Hannibal in Capua" at the Archaeological Museum of Ancient Capua. The exhibition, making use of the same project and the same illustrative and scientific material produced for the 2016 Barletta exhibition, will be displayed in a key linked in particular to the territory of Capua, with new materials and then with new food for thought. The exhibition will be inaugurated on Wednesday, April 18th.
