The Erasmus Days at the IPSEOA “V. Titone” of Castelvetro

On October 10th, the Phoenicians’ Route celebrated the 2023 Erasmus Days together with the IPSEOA “V. Titone” of Castelvetro, involving students in a meeting focused on cultural diversity, European values, and the opportunities offered by the Erasmus programme. The initiative highlighted the importance of intercultural exchange, language skills, and cooperation as key elements for building a more inclusive and connected Europe.

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XVI Euro-Mediterranean Dialogue on the Phoenicians’ Route

The XVI Euro-Mediterranean Dialogue on the Phoenicians’ Route took place in Cabras, Sardinia, from October 18th to 21st, bringing together members, stakeholders, and partners from across Europe and the Mediterranean to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the Route’s recognition as a Cultural Route of the Council of Europe. Through conferences, exhibitions, and thematic meetings, participants explored new strategies for sustainable and regenerative tourism, cultural diplomacy, and cooperation among Mediterranean communities. The event, hosted by the Mont’e Prama Foundation, welcomed international delegations from fifteen countries and reaffirmed a shared commitment to cultural, social, and economic development.

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Learning, Teaching and Training Activity of the QUEST project held in Solin (Croatia)

The QUEST project partners met in Solin, Croatia, from October 24th to 27th for the “HEI and Company Tutors Training and Teaching Program” (LTTA), hosted by the Solin Tourist Board. The meeting focused on preparing the blended mobility programme starting in March 2024, involving students from universities in Croatia, Spain, and Cyprus through online learning activities and international internships with project partners. The partners also worked on training materials, e-learning platform validation, and evaluation methods, while discovering the cultural and natural heritage of the Solin area through dedicated study visits.

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“Ancient Land and Sea Routes as a Key to New Territorial Development Projects” Conference

On November 11th, the conference “Ancient Land and Sea Routes as a Key to New Territorial Development Projects” was held in Selinunte (Sicily), organised by the Phoenicians’ Route – Cultural Route of the Council of Europe, in collaboration with the Archaeological Park of Selinunte, Cave di Cusa, and Pantelleria. Held as part of the celebrations marking the twentieth anniversary of the Route’s certification by the Council of Europe, the event explored strategies for enhancing cultural heritage through the ancient communication networks of the Mediterranean. Particular attention was devoted to the historical and contemporary significance of land and maritime routes, as well as to the role of underwater archaeology and the international projects promoted by the Phoenicians’ Route.

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
