2025 Malta Mediterranean Literature Festival

The Malta Mediterranean Literature Festival, organised annually by Inizjamed, a member of the Phoenicians' Route, in collaboration with Literature Across Frontiers and several national and international partners, is a well-established event promoting contemporary literature and intercultural dialogue. Since its first edition in 2006, the festival has brought together writers and literary translators from Malta, the Mediterranean region and beyond, encouraging exchanges across languages, cultures and artistic disciplines. It took place from August 2nd to August 30th.

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Kick-off meeting of the ECO-SEAROUTES Project in Cyprus

On October 9th - 10th, the Kick-off meeting of the ECO-SEAROUTES Project - co-funded by the Interreg Euro-MED Programme of the European Union - was held in Larnaca (Cyprus). ECO-SEAROUTES aims to create eco-nautical routes connecting ports committed to implementing a common sustainability standard, in a transnational approach, and to redistribute tourist flows to neighbouring coastal and inland areas. Through a regenerative and participatory bottom-up approach, the project involves local decision-makers and tourism operators to enhance peripheral areas and their cultural heritage.

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14th Advisory Forum on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe in Cappadocia, Türkiye

The Phoenicians' Route was present at the 14th Annual Advisory Forum on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe, which was held in Cappadocia, Türkiye from October 22nd to October 24th. This year's topic is "Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe and Landscapes: Advancing Heritage Protection through Cultural and Sustainable Tourism".

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“Malta in the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe” Conference

As part of the Maltese Presidency of the Committee of Ministers of the Council of Europe (May–November 2025), the seminar “Malta in the Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe” was held in Birgu on October 29th and 30th. The Phoenicians’ Route played a prominent role in the event as the first Cultural Route of the Council of Europe with members in Malta.
